

LIFE EnerGISE MAIN OBJECTIVES

1. Streamline the creation and growth of energy communities in Central Europe by building a strong network of one-stop shops offering tailored support.

2. Adapt and develop know-how, methods, and tools to meet the needs of early-stage energy communities and make this knowledge accessible across the region.

Planned key achievements

- Information Tools (Fact sheets, Good practices, Useful links, incl. platforms & databases, Frequently asked questions related to energy communities)
- Capacity-building workshops, trained experts, contribution to ENERCOM related events, final conference
- Replication beyond 5 pilot OSS at the last stage
- Report on persisting barriers to ENERCOM setup or development

KPIs

- 380 / 665* energy community projects supported
- 57 / 100* energy communities formed/established
- 13 / 13* operational support services provided to energy communities that have been tested and established, including incorporated user feedback;
- 5700 / 10 000* citizens participating in energy communities as a result of the project
- 600 / 1 800* participants with improved community energy skills (municipal/city/regional officials or other relevant actors)

 Replication and exploitation of the project outputs.
- AB Recommendations will help to design the key project deliverables reflecting actual energy community demand.


